

Ten Essential Strategies For Inclusion

Use their special interest to motivate them

As a teacher do not take behaviours personally

Open the library for them at lunchtime to retreat to for time away from other students.

Be clear of what is required of the student. Remember they are very literal.

Provide clubs to join at lunchtime. The playground is too stressful for most ASD students. They need structure as found in clubs (chess, guitar etc) without too much socialisation.

Have structures in place to reduce stress levels so the students can cope with the afternoon socialisation in class.

Set up school boundaries.

Develop a good rapport with the student.

Have safety nets in place for the teacher, student and peers.

Have clear rules and expectations
